

RPI Tool Manual

To calculate the Reuse Potential Index (RPI), you need to follow a few steps. This document provides a basic explanation of how the tool works. A [video](#) is also available that walks you through the application. In addition, there is a “Frequently Asked Questions” section at the end of this manual.

Login

Go to <https://cbcompass.eu/rpindex> and enter the username and password you received. You will be redirected to <https://app.anticde.io/>, where you can continue with your calculation.

1. Create a variant

For each design, several variants can be calculated. Here you have an overview of the different variants and you can create a variant.

2. Create a reference cross-section

For each variant you can create a reference cross-section. This is the build-up of a facade that you are going to calculate. Each cross-section has a certain coverage ratio (the ratio of the facade build-up to the total facade). This can be expressed in percentages, meters or other units (as long as you keep it consistent).

3. Run the calculation

You can add parts to the calculation. You can then specify the properties of each part and which other parts it is connected to. Each property includes a description of what happens with that property.

4. Results

Next you can go to the results tab to view the RPI, compare it to other reference cross-sections relative to the total. In addition, there are tips available to increase reusability.

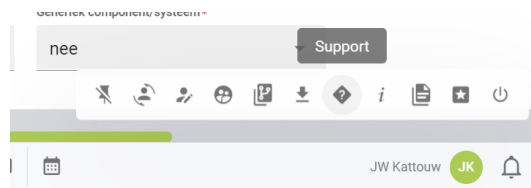
